



Temporary: Justice for Victims Legal Clinic Attorney (40 hours/week, 3-month position)

The Vermont Network is seeking an attorney for a temporary position to provide free legal services to victims of abuse and assault. Responsibilities may include conducting intakes with clients, providing legal advice and representing clients in family, civil or other legal matters. This is a temporary role extending to September 30th. Individuals may be able to reapply for a permanent, benefitted position in October contingent on grant funding.

The Vermont Network is a statewide non-profit organization working to end domestic and sexual violence in our state. The Justice for Victims Legal Clinic is a small clinic and a program of the Vermont Network which provides free legal services to victims of domestic and sexual violence across Vermont. Candidates must be a member of the Vermont Bar and able to practice law in Vermont. Experience with family law and understanding of the dynamics of domestic and sexual violence preferred. Hours will be split between a home office setting and our office in Waterbury, Vermont. The salary for this non-benefitted, temporary position is \$55,000.
